Dear Parents

Please complete the attached enrolment form for Term 3 After School Art for Toorak Primary School if your child is attending.

Term 3 is 10 weeks of school, with classes starting on the first week back.

Monday 10th of July • 10 weeks \$275 inc. GST

Wednesday 12th July • 10 weeks \$275 inc. GST

Thursday 13th July • 10 weeks \$275 inc. GST

All classes **start at 3.45pm**, allowing students to run around outside for 15 minutes supervised (by the school) before starting art class. Classes **finish at 5.15pm**. I always arrive prior to school ending to prepare. Students are required to put on a provided blue vest (available at the art room door) for identification immediately at the end of school, this is a TPS safety requirement.

Please send a text message for confirmation if your child will not be attending class on any given day. Makeup classes are available on request also.

A small snack is provided at the start of class, please consider adding something extra to your child's lunchbox if they require something further. It is also really important that I am informed of any food allergies, and a suitable snack brought by the student for safety if necessary. Unfortunately I am no longer allowed to bring prepared fruit, so its usually biscuits or a small cake of some kind, and icy treats in the warmer weather.

Students have access to class smocks which are shared, but you are very welcome to provide your own.

I provide all art materials which vary each term. I try to incorporate a variety of mediums and projects each term to allow students to experiment and enjoy a wide range of materials. I encourage students to try all projects, but sometimes they prefer to do something of their own choice. Although this can have its advantages, I usually find students end up with lots of unfinished work which they throw away. If your child doesn't bring finished works home, please feel free to discuss with me; it may be that I have it in the art room - I have LOTS! It may be that they chat too much and don't finish, we have quite a delicate balance (sometimes very unbalanced) between having fun in the room with friends, and enjoying/working on our art.

Most of you probably know that I am a school relief teacher through the week, but only work part days on the days (if a part day is available through my work) I am at TPS, to ensure I arrive on time. After School Art classes are easily my most challenging art classes due to the varying abilities and ages. I try to make each project scalable, so all students can work to their ability with a result they are proud of. This can also mean I get extra busy assisting the younger students that require a little extra help. I definitely push artistic boundaries at times. There is also a lot more freedom being as its extra curricular and we want it to be fun for everyone.
