PROJECT UPDATE

Construction is now underway and will continue until late 2018. This will ensure the school is ready to accept the inaugural Year 7 cohort for the commencement of the 2019 school year.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

Prahran High School will be a co-educational secondary school for 650 students. The school will open in Term 1, 2019 with its first Year 7 students.

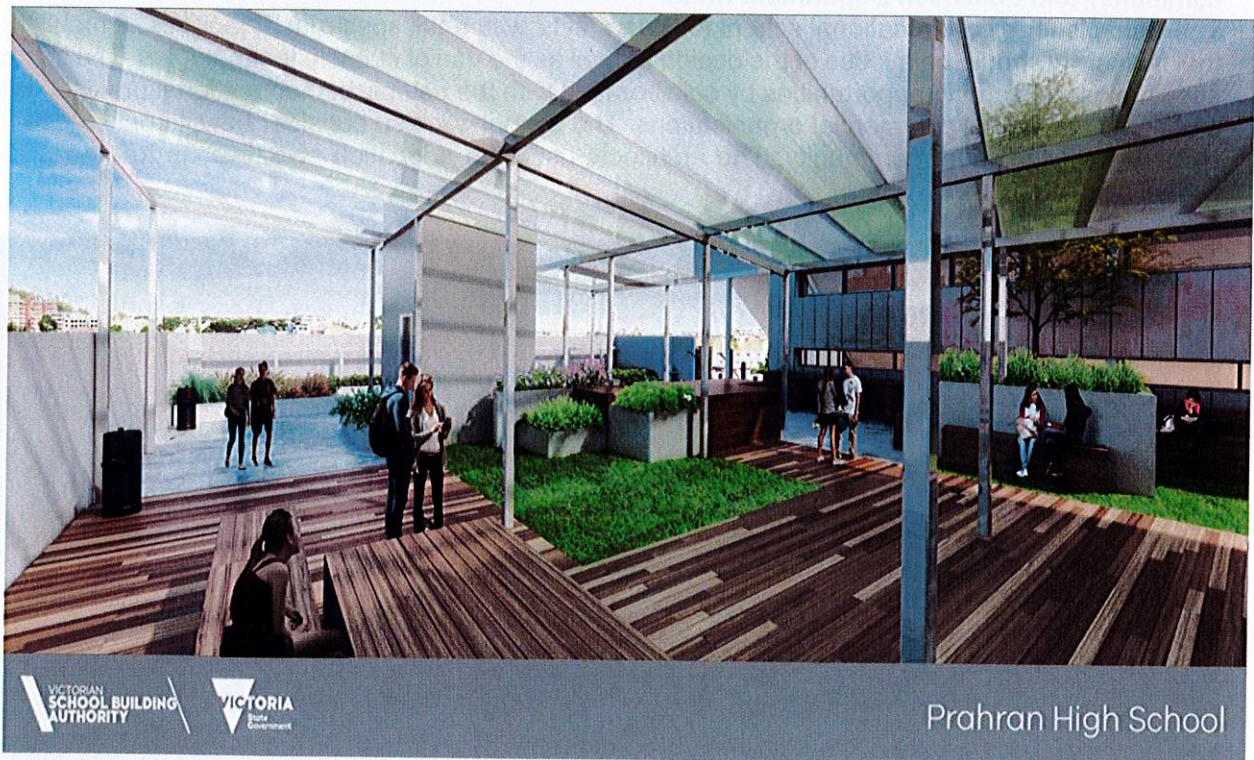
We're building this innovative, vertical school next to an existing educational precinct that includes Melbourne Polytechnic and the National Institute of Circus Arts.

A New School Planning Group, NSPG, made up of parents, educational experts, project planners and representatives of the community, oversees design and development.

Their first task was creating an 'education specification' – a vision defining what kind of school the community and Education Department want.

The vision is for a co-educational school for Years 7-12 with a full spectrum of facilities. It highlights that inclusivity should be a focus of the design as well as the use of suitable technologies. The school should explore learning opportunities by collaborating with the established educational precinct, arts community and local commercial organisations. The school will also consider how it could share its facilities with the wider community. The architects used the education specification to design the school's master plan.
