

TPS TRIVIA NIGHT – ANSWERS TO ALL YOUR QUESTIONS

With just 1 week to go before our fabulous Trivia Night, we thought it would be useful to compile some questions answered. If your question is not answered here, please contact us via the front office.

1. What shall I wear? Dress your best ready for some fun.
2. I haven't decided if I'm going to go or not. When is the cut-off to purchase a ticket? Lunchtime Thursday 17 August!!
3. Can I bring my own food? Yes, you can bring your own food, grab some pizzas or burgers from Glenferrie Rd or whip up some cheese platter to share with your table.
4. Can I bring something to drink? Due to the licensing laws at the venue no drinks – either alcoholic or non-alcoholic, can be brought to the venue.
5. How much will drinks cost on the night? From \$3.50 for soft drinks to \$65 for French champagne with lots of options in between.
6. Do I need cash on the night? Eftpos will be the preferred method of payment, however we can accept cash. No cheques or IOU's! There will be Raffle Tickets for incredible prizes, which can be bought on the night from one of our roaming sellers or on Qkr until midday Thursday 17th.
7. I can't find a babysitter. Can I bring my child? This event is a child-free event and we encourage everyone to come along and enjoy uninterrupted, adult conversation with our fabulous school community. Spend time with friends and meet some new ones!
8. Where is the Malvern Town Hall? On the corner of Glenferrie Road and High Street, Malvern and there is ample parking in neighbouring streets, or a tram can drop you at the door.
9. What time does it start and finish? Doors open at 6.30pm and the night will finish around 11pm.
10. Where will I be sitting? People will be at the entrance area with seating plans letting you know where you are sitting. If you have nominated a 'table captain' you will be with those people, or if you are coming alone or have not nominated a 'table captain', we will allocate you to a table with your child's grade level. Remember you are surrounded by friends and a fantastic community, so don't worry if you are coming 'alone'.
11. What can I expect on the night? FUN! We have a professional Trivia Night host who will run two 40 minute trivia sessions, there will be some amusing challenges (optional!), a chance to buy a few raffle tickets for some great prizes and enjoy some drinks and food in a lovely relaxed atmosphere.
12. Can I buy some raffle tickets if I am not going to the night? Yes, of course. Jump onto QKR! and purchase some tickets. The raffle will be drawn on the night but if you are not there, it doesn't matter.
13. What are we raising money for? All profits for the night are going to our school's fundraising fund, with a focus on improving play equipment, shading in the playground and the surface of the multi-purpose courts.
