CRANE WORKS IN BROOKVILLE ROAD FOR TOORAK PRIMARY SCHOOL

As you may have noticed there has been preparatory building works at the Toorak Primary School ready for delivery of portable sections of new classrooms.

As such you are advised that crane works need to proceed on three days **(1) Mon 11 Dec (2) Thur 14 Dec and (3) Fri 15 Dec 2017** in Brookville Road (between Fairbairn & Canterbury Roads) beside the school and as such this notice serves as information of the likely impact of this activity.

These works involve the use of a mobile crane to place portable sections of the new classrooms and unfortunately involves a temporary road closure in Brookville Road during crane lifting from trucks standing in Brookville Road.

Also to enable the works to proceed safely the south footpath in Brookville Road beside the school will also be closed during these works. Traffic controllers will be in place to assist with pedestrian movements & local access to the opposite side of Brookville Road.

Local vehicle access in Brookville Road to be from either Fairbairn or Canterbury Road during the works at the school.

Although the works are substantial, every effort will be made to minimize impact to businesses and the general public. The following treatments will apply:

- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times
- Access to the school maintained at all times
- Access to all properties will be maintained.
- Vehicle access / egress (i.e. local traffic) still available up to the closure. Traffic management personnel will help local residents with access to and from local streets.
- The roads / footpaths are open overnight

The use of mobile cranes in streets is never an easy task however we will attempt to minimise the impact of these works and apologise in advance for any inconvenience that may be caused.

Although the works will be difficult for local traders and residents, your co-operation will be appreciated. Thank you.
